### Remote Learning Update November 2021



### **What can we expect from the school if our child has tested positive or is waiting for a test result?**

This advice needs to be read in conjunction with our remote learning policy which can be found on our website under the policy section.

We recognise that the national and local situation regarding Covid is changing all the time. In addition to this, every family situation will be slightly different so what pupils can achieve at home will vary. We would like to support the education of every child who is not able to come into school due to waiting for a test or in the event of a positive result. Hopefully the updated guidance below will clarify what is expected.

First of all, we **do not** expect pupils who are too ill to work to complete remote learning. In this situation, the child taking the time to recover and be able to attend after their 10-day period of isolation is our first priority. Children who are well and waiting for a test result are expected to complete work at home.

However, we do recognise that some pupils can test positive and be able to complete some work at home. Hopefully the guidance below will clarify how we would like to support our pupils.

**Step 1:** Once parents have notified the office that their child will be absent due to Covid, the office will direct the parents to some tasks on our website for the child to complete (if able to do so) on the first day of absence. The office will ask the parent if they are able to access Seesaw at home.

**Step 2:** Once the office has notified the Classteacher that a child in their class will be absent, the Classteacher will post some tasks on Seesaw for the child to access from day 2 of the absence.

**Step 3:** The Classteacher will respond to the tasks being completed and provide new tasks each day.

Should parents not be able to access Seesaw then they may request a pack of activities for the child to complete at home which will be available for the parents to collect from the office.

The tasks that we will post on Seesaw will match class activities as far as possible and the suggested timings etc will be as detailed in our remote learning policy.
