<p>Attainment in Maths– by gender</p>	<p>Y2: 84 % of girls met the key benchmarks by the end of July 2021 88 % of boys met the key benchmarks by the end of July 2021</p> <p>Y6 68% of girls met the key benchmarks by the end of July 2021 80% of boys met the key benchmarks by the end of July 2021</p>
<p>Y1 phonics</p>	<p>Overall, 89% of pupils passed. 89% of boys passed the phonics check and 89% of girls passed. Our disadvantaged child passed. Our child taking the phonics retake passed. 33% of SEN pupils passed.</p>
<p>Attainment of SEN pupils</p>	<p>In Y2, 1 child met the reading standard and both met the standard in maths. In Y6, 2 out of our 8 children met the expected benchmarks.</p>
<p>Attainment of Disadvantaged pupils.</p>	<p>In Y2, one of our children combined to meet the benchmarks in reading, writing and maths. In Y6, 3 out of 7 pupils combined to meet the benchmarks and 1 met the benchmarks in writing and reading. 1 out of 7 met the greater depth standard in reading, writing and maths.</p>
<p>Attainment by race</p>	<p>In Y6, 100% of our EAL pupils met the expected benchmarks.</p>
<p>Participation in the student council 2020- March 2021</p>	<p>9 pupils represented the school council this year. 3 were boys and 6 were girls. These pupils were elected by their peers.</p>
<p>Participation in After School sports Clubs</p>	<p>145 places were taken up by pupils. 8% were taken up by disadvantaged pupils, 49% by boys and 51% by girls. 5% were taken up by SEN and 3% EAL.</p>
<p>Governor awards 2021-22</p>	<p>28 awards were given out. 12 were to girls and 16 to boys. 10% premium pupils received an award, one service child and 10% SEN pupils and one EAL pupil. This is representative of our school population.</p>
<p>Governor representation</p>	<p>Including staff, we had 4 males and 9 females on the Governing body last academic year.</p>
<p>Racial Incidents logged</p>	<p>There were no racial incidents logged this year.</p>
